Any contestant ranked in SRA Point Standings that competed in at least five SRA first-sanctioned rodeos in that event **MUST SUBMIT ENTRY**. Point Standings are available on website. The Top 12 in each event will be taken, but the highest ranked alternates that enter will be accepted if Top 12 fails to enter. Top 12 Headers and Heelers must pair. SFR contestant roster will be published on website after books close.

PAYMENT due by Monday, February 5 at 4:00pm EST for Entry Fees, Camping Hookups, Stalls & Ground Fees: Pay ONLINE with Mastercard/VISA at www.srarodeo.com/upcoming-events or mail check or money order along with the enclosed payment form.

CHECK IN & MANDATORY MEETING: Friday, February 23 at 2:00pm EST

Contestants, Stock Contractors & Personnel must meet in the seating area behind announcer stand. Contestant armband, jacket and information packet which includes one guest pass for each performance will be given at this time. Election for board of directors and event directors will take place during meeting. **Any contestant not present when called will be fined \$50 which must be paid before competing.** No exceptions.

HOST HOTEL & TICKET INFORMATION will be posted on SRA website as soon as available.

STALLS, CAMPING HOOKUPS and GROUND FEES INFORMATION

Camping Hookups are first-come, first-served. No trailer over 30ft allowed in area between arena building and adjacent barns. Tent camping not allowed. The facility charges for any trailer hooked to power for any length of time and for any RV parked on grounds with or without power. Facility employees count each day and if you are included in their count, you will be liable. If you are hooked up Friday morning when facility employees take count, you will be charged for Thursday night. Facility charges \$60 per night for hookups, this is the amount due if you prepay by due date. If you wait to purchase at finals, the charge will be \$80 per night cash only.

Stalls are preassigned based on receipt of payment. If you need stalls next to someone in particular, mail payment together or submit online payment for stalls in the same transaction. The facility charges for stalls used for any amount of time and requires all horses on grounds overnight to be in stalls. You will be charged for a stall if you have a horse on the grounds overnight that is not in a stall. Facility charges \$80 per stall for weekend, this is the amount due if you prepay by due date. If you wait to purchase at finals, the charge will be \$100 per stall cash only. **Shavings are not included and will not be available at the facility. You must bring your own shavings.**

Ground Fees: The facility charges a ground fee for each horse on the property. Ground fee is included in price of stall. If you do not purchase a stall, you must pay the \$30 fee for each horse that you bring on grounds.
